












* Stop 1: Rainforestation Nature Park Tropical Breakfast

Our adventure begins at Rainforestation Nature Park, nestled in the heart of the Kuranda rainforest. This family-owned gem offers us an exclusive tropical breakfast on the balcony of their charming Tree House Restaurant. Enjoy seasonal tropical fruits, wattle seed damper paired with a selection of tropical iams, and locally sourced tea and coffee.

After breakfast, indulae in a tasting of their unique liqueurs from Mountain Groves Distillery, which are made on site: Mango & Chilli, Pineapple & Cinnamon, Lemon Myrtle Cello, Passionfruit & Pepperberry



Stop 2: Emerald Creek Ice Creamery

Our second stop takes us to Emerald Creek Ice Creamery, a family-owned treasure nestled on 2.15 hectares along the Kennedy Highway between Mareeba and Kuranda.

Their ice cream is lovingly <mark>crafted</mark> on-site using pure cream and full-cream milk, while their dairy-free sorbets are made with local Tablelands fruit, bursting with tropical flavour.

Relax on the balcony or in the lush gardens as you sayour a delightful tasting of unique, tropical ice creams and sorbets - a sweet treat you won't forget!





Stop 3: The Humpy Nut World

Y Stop 6: Mount Uncle Distillery **Award-Winning Spirits & Native Flavours**

A pioneer in North Queensland's distilling scene, Mount Uncle Distillery was the region's first-ever distillery and has been crafting premium spirits since 2002.

Named Australian Distiller of the Year in 2017, they continue to lead the way with their award-winning liqueurs and spirits, infused with native Australian botanicals.

Stop 7: Private Rainforest Retreat Queensland Wine, Beer & Wildlife
